Please ensure that your workers comply with the Covid-19 Regulation as far as social distancing, washing of hands, and masks are concerned as a minimum.

The automated gates will remain closed during Level 3 so also the R59 gates until further notice. Many restrictions still apply and can be better controlled from one gate.

It is a pity all our golfing members haven't been able to enjoy the course over the last couple of weeks as it was really looking nice but with the recent cold it has just about lost its color overnight. Various messages are doing the rounds but until we receive official confirmation from the South African Golf Association the course will remain closed. The same applies to tennis and squash.
