



PARYS GOLF AND COUNTRY ESTATE HOSE RULES REGARDING DOMESTIC ANIMALS

These rules will be enforceable as from July 1, 2010.

Parys Golf & Country Estate (PGCE) wishes to inform all homeowners that the policy regarding the keeping of domestic animals on the estate will be enforced as from July 1, 2010. This policy that originally prohibited the keeping of animals, pets, livestock or poultry of ANY KIND was revised at the first AGM held on 24 February 2007 to allow homeowners to keep dogs as pets on their property. Homeowners should refer to the original rule 5.10 in this regard, and to the notes of the first AGM. The following rule regarding the keeping of dogs as pets will thus apply as from July 1, 2010. Please note that the original policy (rule 5.10) that prohibits cats as pets on the property still applies.

Dogs shall be limited to two per household and shall not be allowed off the members property unless on a leash. Dogs thus are not permitted in, or to be walked in, the natural veldt or on the golf course without a leash. Homeowners will only be allowed to play their SMALL dogs on designated park areas if these animals are under strict control and no danger to other inhabitants. Excessive barking of dogs will at all times not be tolerated.

Homeowners shall also provide the Estate Manager with the following written details of their dogs: name, breed, description and a photograph for registration purposes. All unregistered animals found will be impounded and removed from the Estate.

Homeowners must ensure that they install a suitable enclosure, **approved by the Aesthetic and Environmental Committee** to prevent their dogs from straying off their property. Any unauthorized structures must be removed and in the event of failing to do so a fine regarding the PGCE House Rules will be implied and the resident or tenant will be held responsible for the costs of the removal of such a structure by the PGCE HOA.

Every resident and homeowner is thus asked to please co-operate and make sure that they know and understand the contents of the PGCE House Rules regarding Domestic Animals. Homeowners that do not adhere to these rules will be fined. Moreover, dogs found roaming in the veldt or on the golf course will be removed from the Estate and impounded by die SPCA. Moreover, homeowners may forfeit the privilege of keeping pets on the property if they continue to ignore these rules.
