On Thursday 2 July, the Board received a complaint from the Federation for a Sustainable Environment (FSE) that was solely based on allegations submitted to them by Mrs. Barbera Jansen van Rensburg, a resident and member of the PGCE HOA. FSE is spearheaded by the renowned activist Mariette Liefferink.

The grounds for the complaint was based on the alleged non-compliance with the national water act (36 of 1998) and numerous documents originally filed (2004/2005) by the Developer to obtain approval for our Estate from the relevant authorities. These include the environmental management plan, the record of decision and the mitigation measures in terms of the final scoping report.

Mrs. Liefferink was invited to visit the estate on Saturday 4 July, to discuss the complaint and the document that she submitted.

After a lengthy discussion and site survey the overall findings were positive, and Mrs. Liefferink and her daughter were complimentary of our beautiful estate. There were suggestions made regarding certain areas on the golf course and other common properties.

As per the procedures stipulated in our Environmental Management Policy, which includes liaison with our PGCE Environmental and Garden Club, an implementation plan will be developed and executed as funds allow.
