### Environmental Affairs

We are glad to announce that the Board has approved the appointment of Michael Seiderer (Pr.Sci.Nat) from Greenthorn Environmental Solutions as the Estates Environmental Control Officer. He will do regular visits to help advise on environmental issues and concerns. All communication with Michael will be through the office.

By now most residents would have noticed the workers from the department of Environmental Affairs that have been active on the estate with the removal of invasive species. Two groups are busy at the eastern side of the estate and one group is busy with the removal of the hyacinth at the irrigation dam. This project will continue well into the new year as they make their way down from the Feesgronde side.

Apart from the removal of invasive trees and plants, there will also be cutting of thorn trees in certain overpopulated areas.

We once again urge residents not to cut any trees outside of their property boundaries without first getting approval.

The Quarry will be burned during this coming week weather permitting under the watchful eye of LGV (Landelike Gebieds Veiligheid).
